## Visual Evidence of Asbestos at the Former GM Property

Asbestos has been observed throughout the site: in the halfdemolished buildings, the debris piles and on the ground. Asbestos abatement has not been completed. Asbestos wrapped pipes are still in place.



Asbestos wrapped pipes are damaged in many places.




Asbestos abatement has not been completed. Degraded asbestos wrapped pipes are still in place.
